

HOW TO DISABLE POP-UP BLOCKER

Pop-up blockers are great at keeping annoying advertising off your computer screen. However, there are times when you'll need the information a pop-up contains. In those cases, you'll want to disable your browser's pop-up blocker.

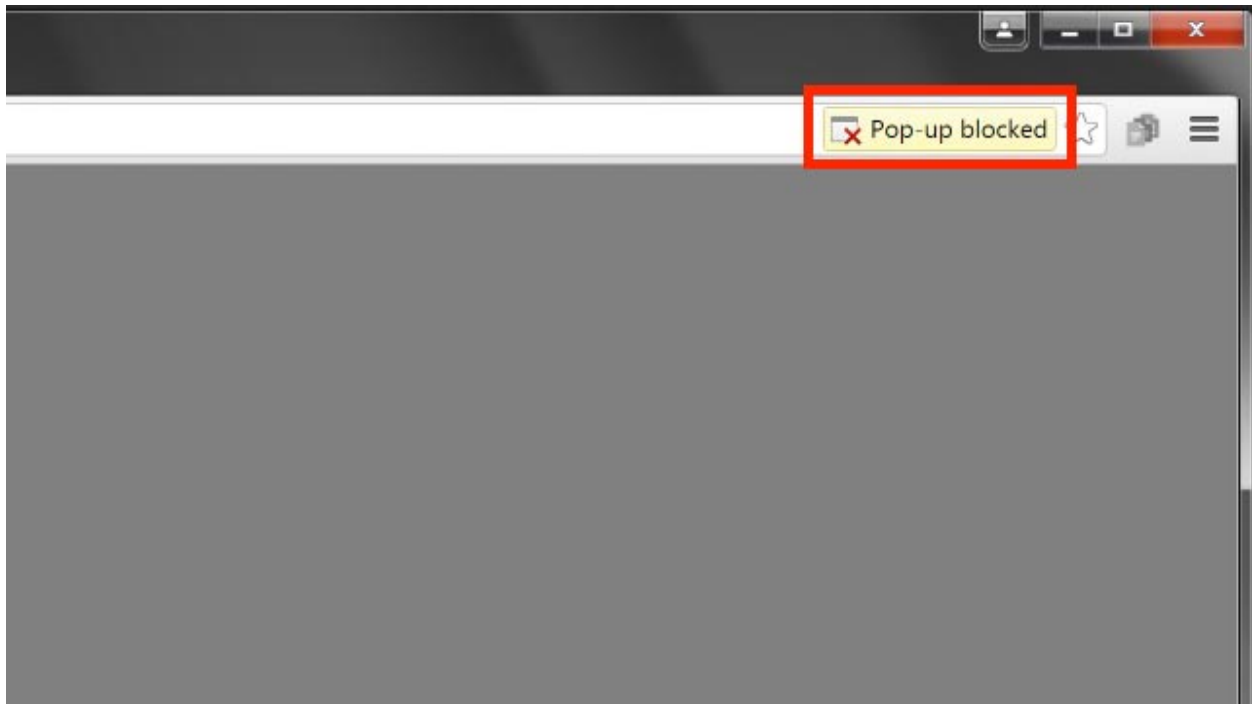

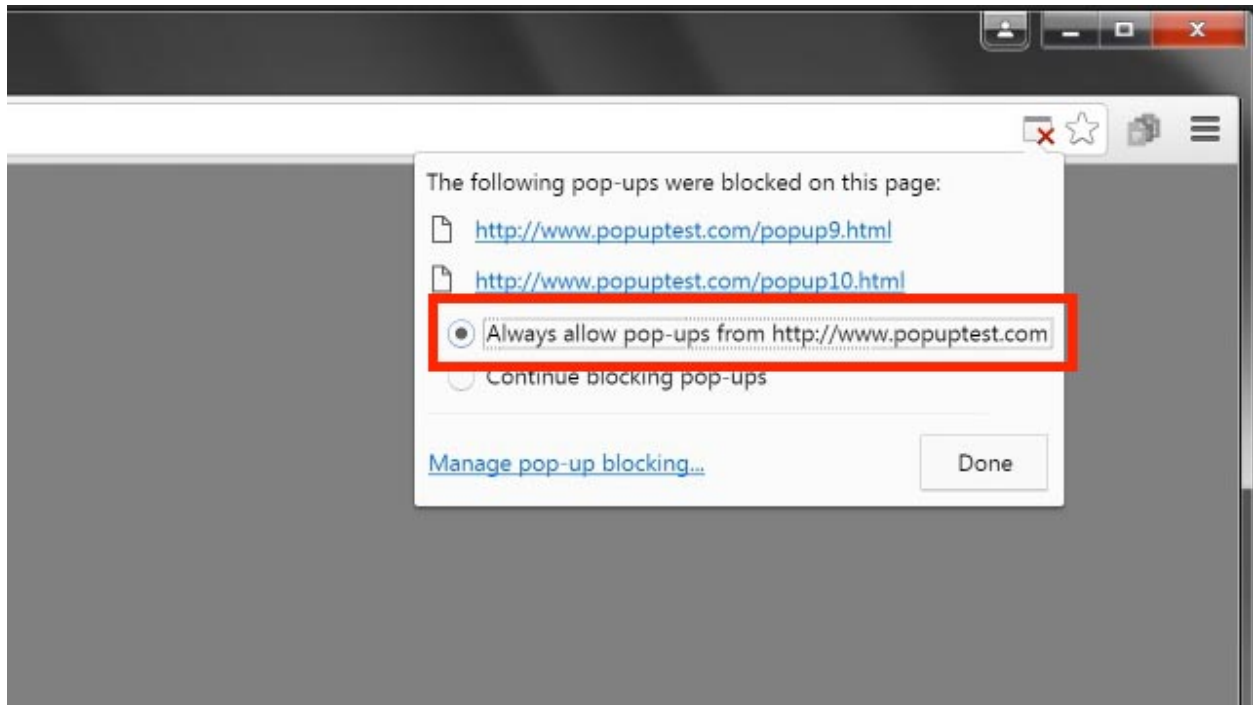
Disable a pop-up blocker on a web page.

Clicking the icon will allow you to:

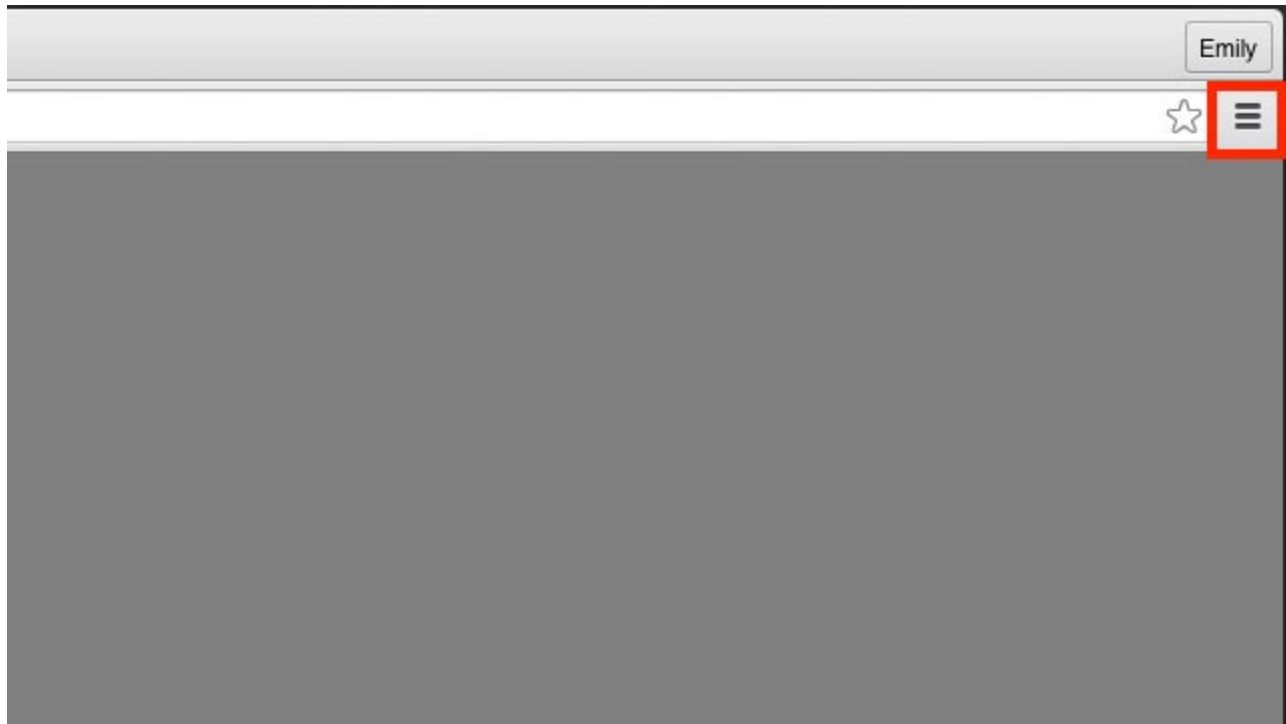
- Always allow pop-ups from this site

- Manage pop-up blocking



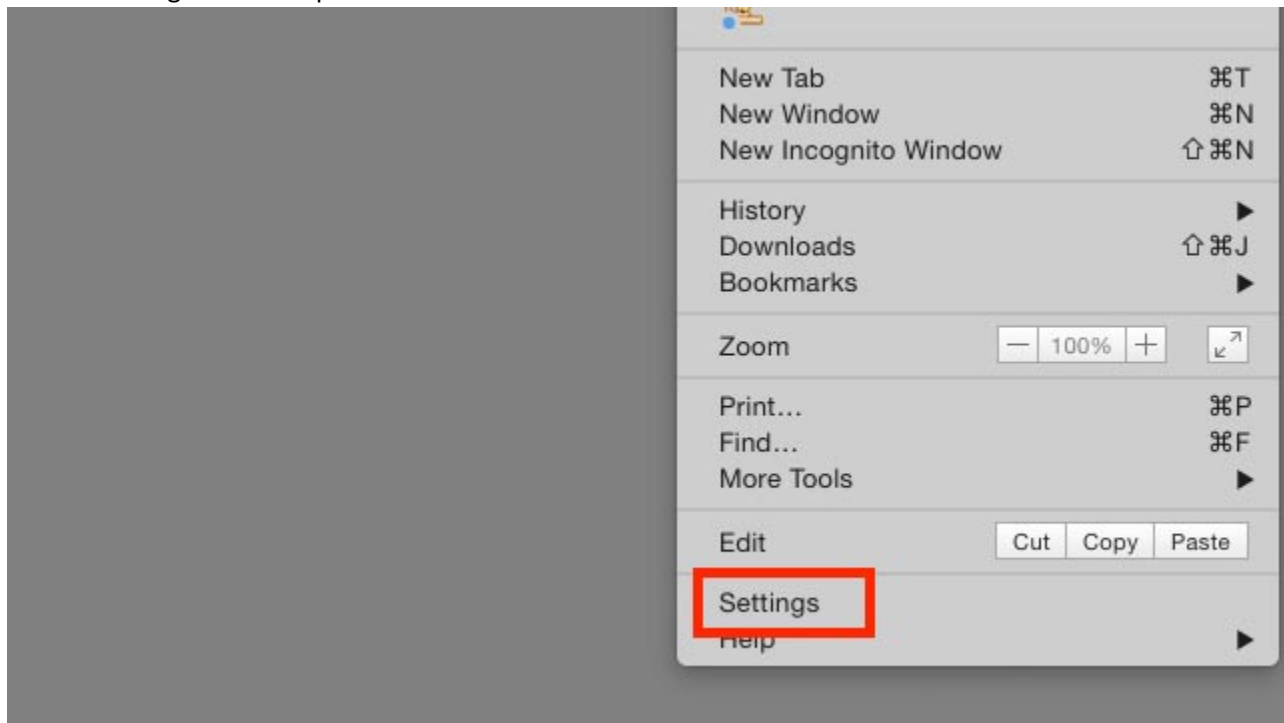


Disable a pop-up blocker within Chrome settings.

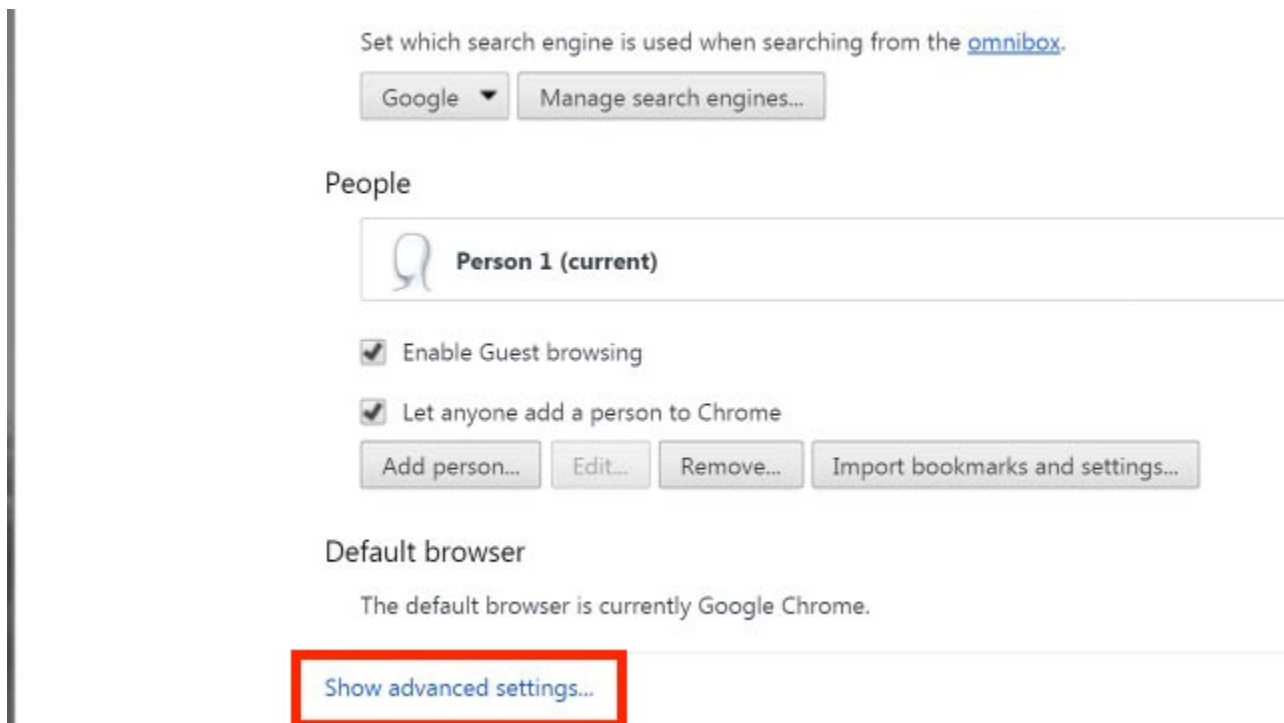
1. Open Chrome.
2. Click the Chrome menu in the upper right corner.



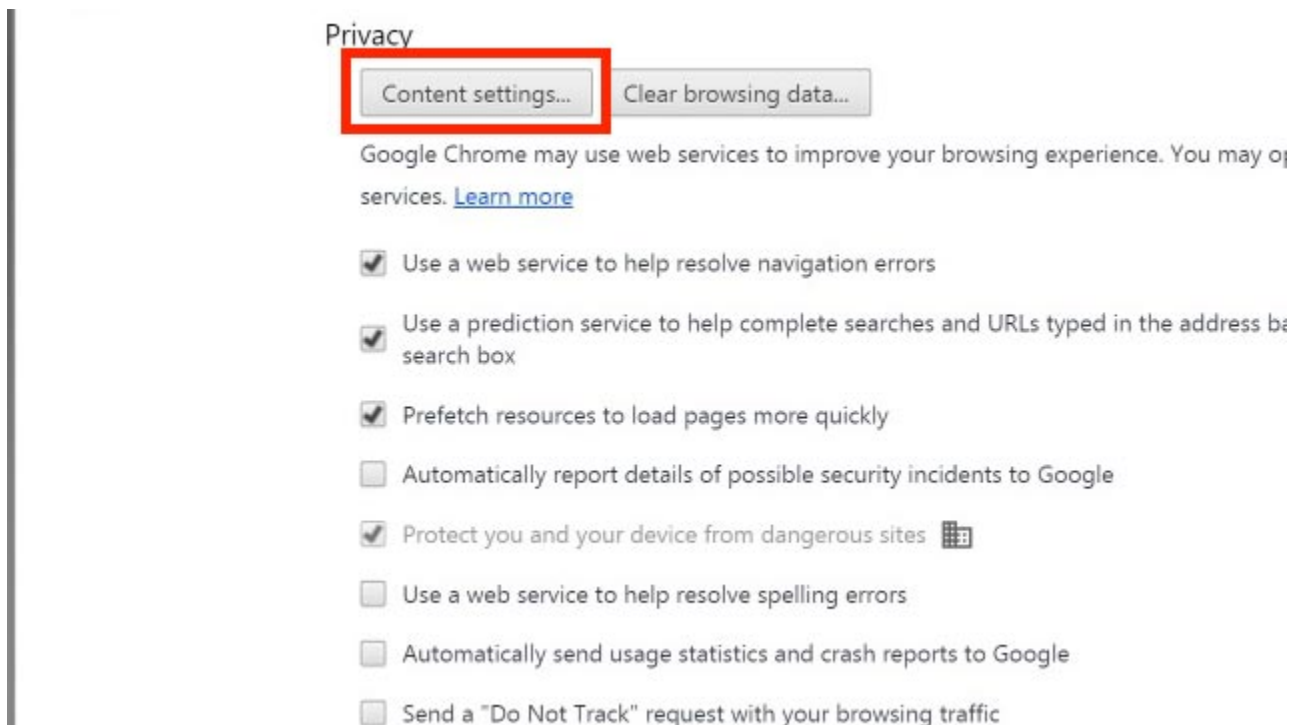
3. Click Settings in the drop-down menu.



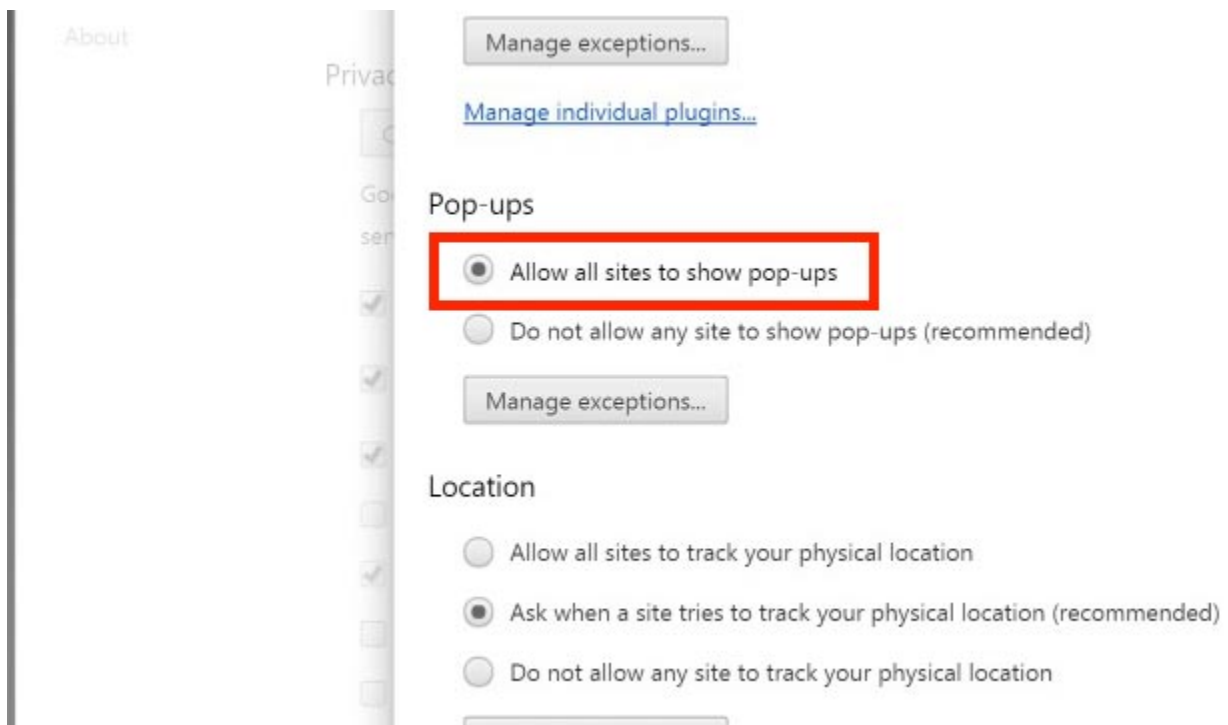
4. At the bottom of the page, click Show advanced settings....



5. Under Privacy, click Content settings....



6. Under Pop-ups, select Allow all sites to show pop-ups.



7. Click Done in the bottom right-hand corner.

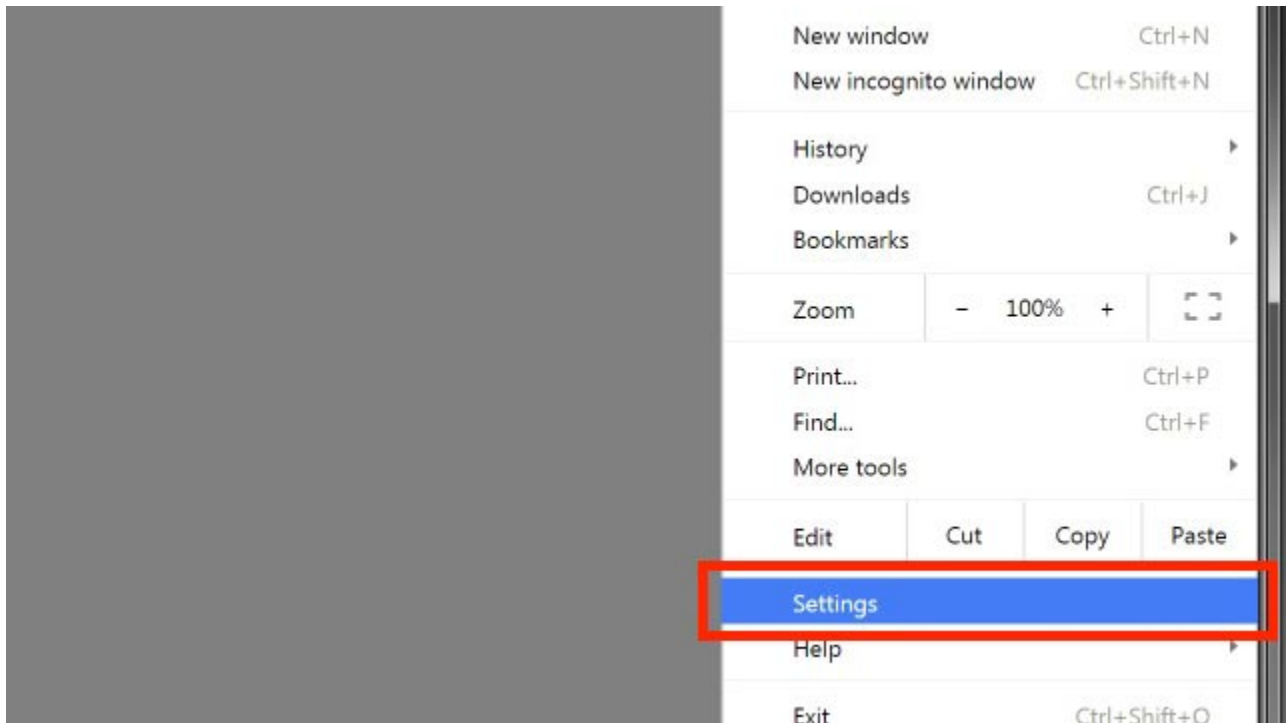

Edge for PC

Disable a pop-up blocker within Edge settings.

1. Open Edge.
2. Click the three-dotted More actions, then click Settings within the drop-down menu.
3. Scroll down to Advanced Settings and click View advanced settings.
4. Under Block pop-ups slide the setting to On.

Firefox for PC

2. Click the Firefox menu in the upper right.



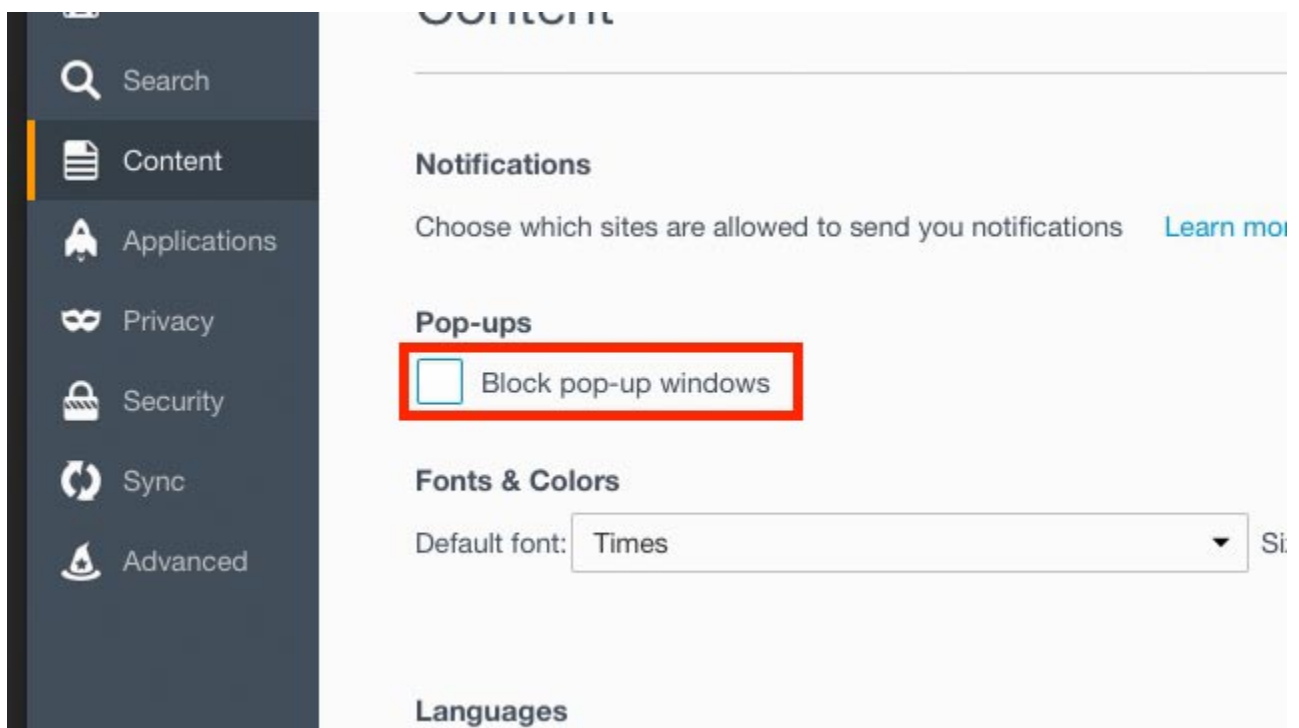
3. Click Options in the drop-down menu.

5. Under Pop-ups uncheck Block pop-up windows.



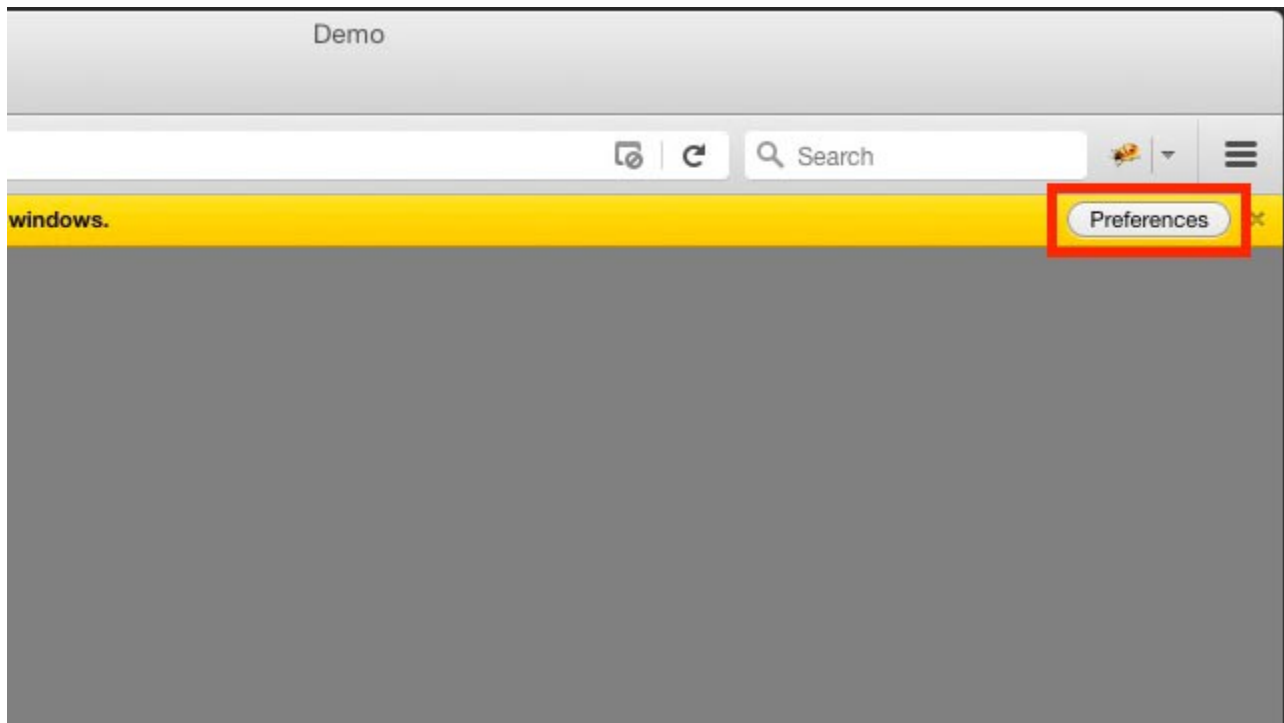

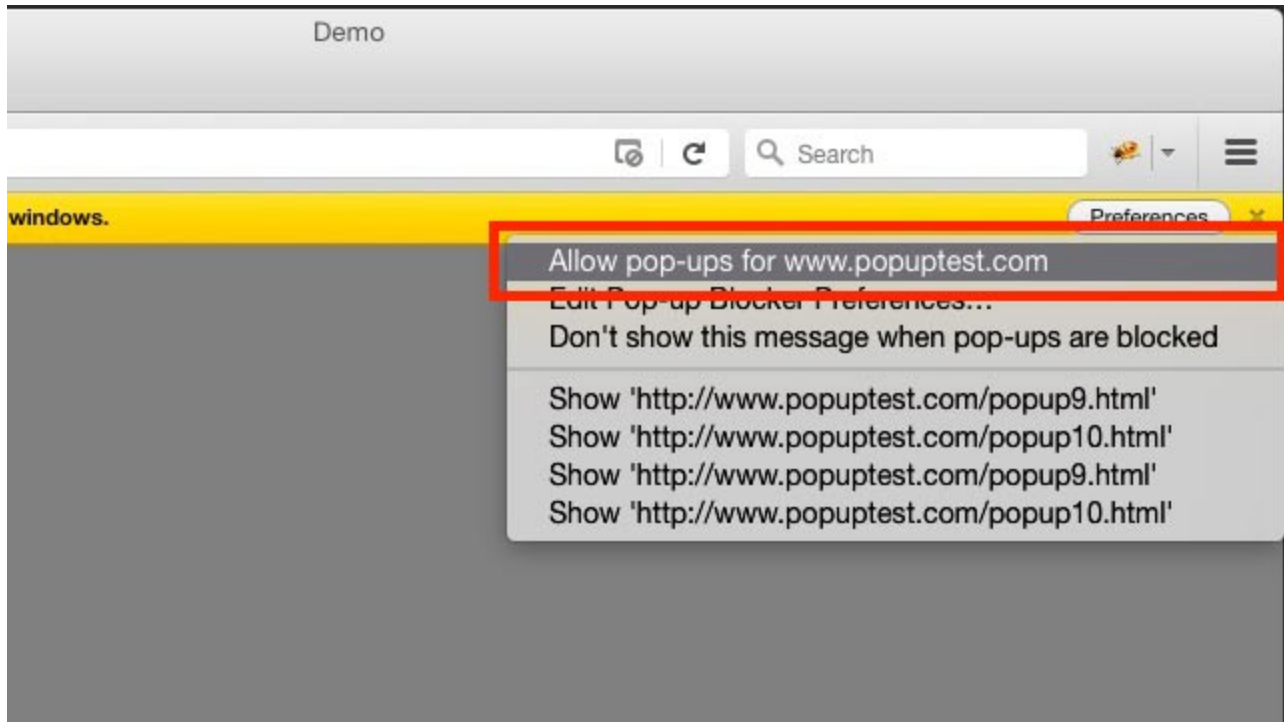

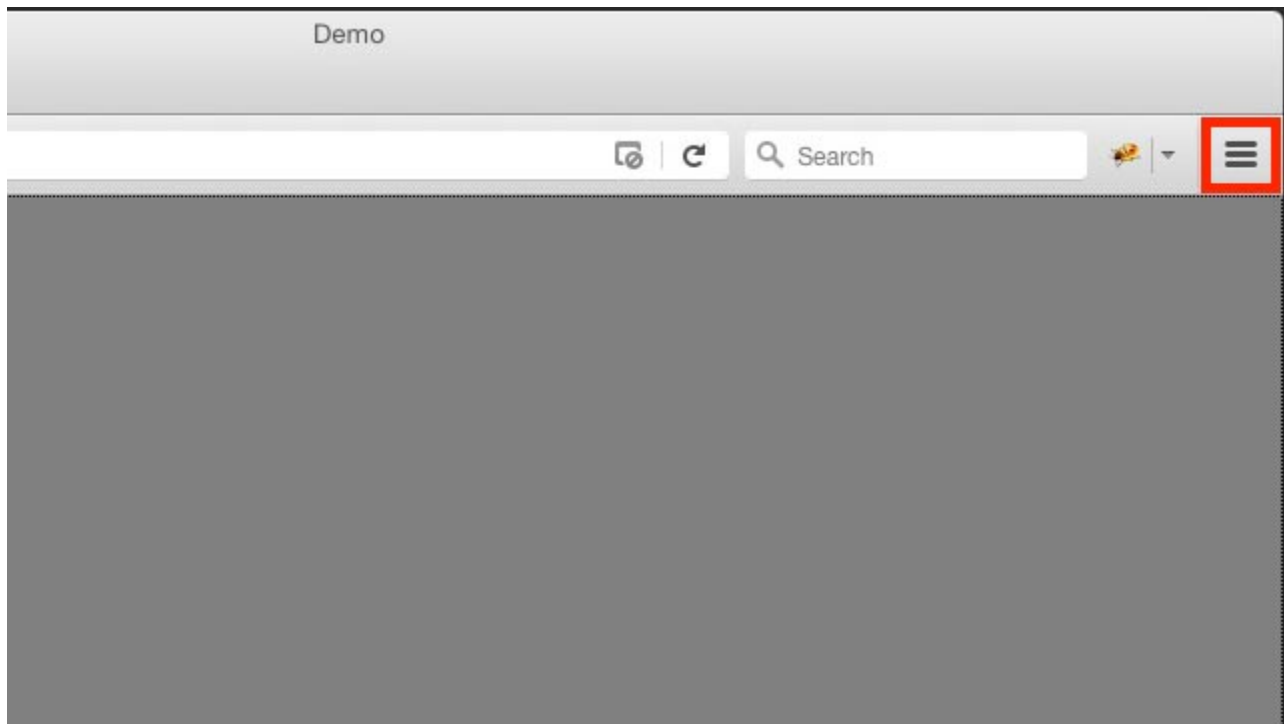

- Display the blocked pop-up window



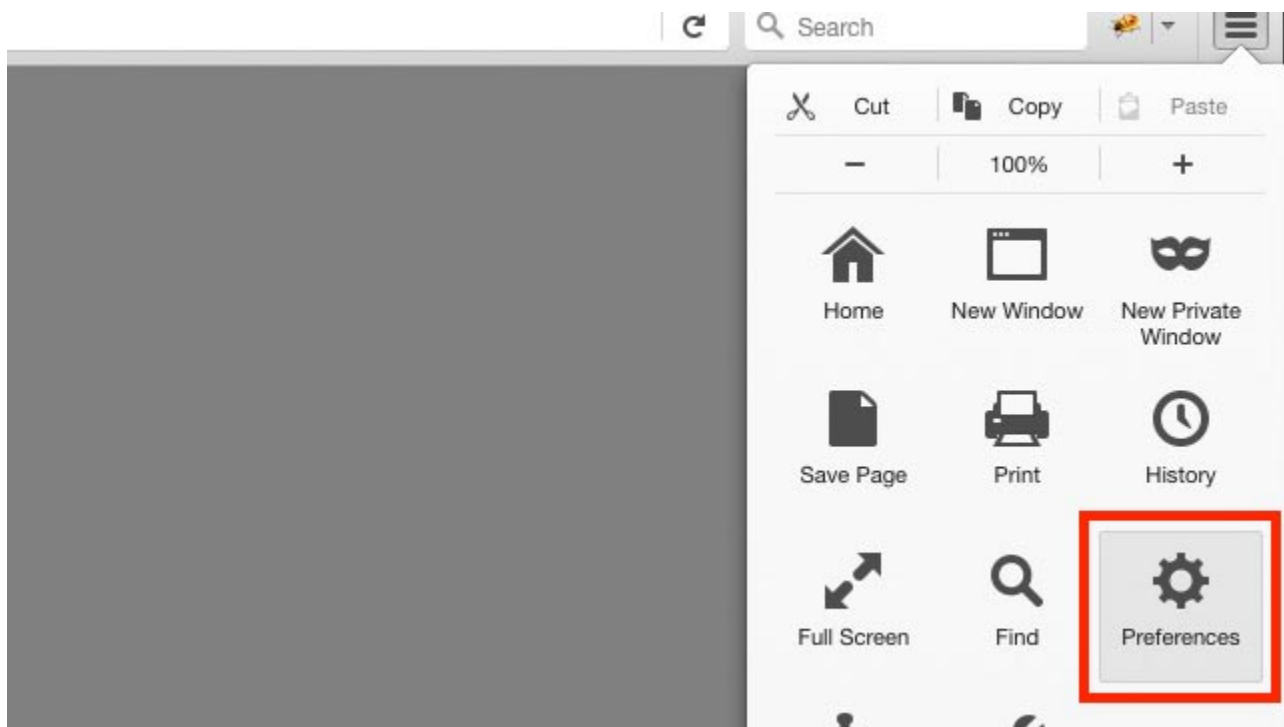

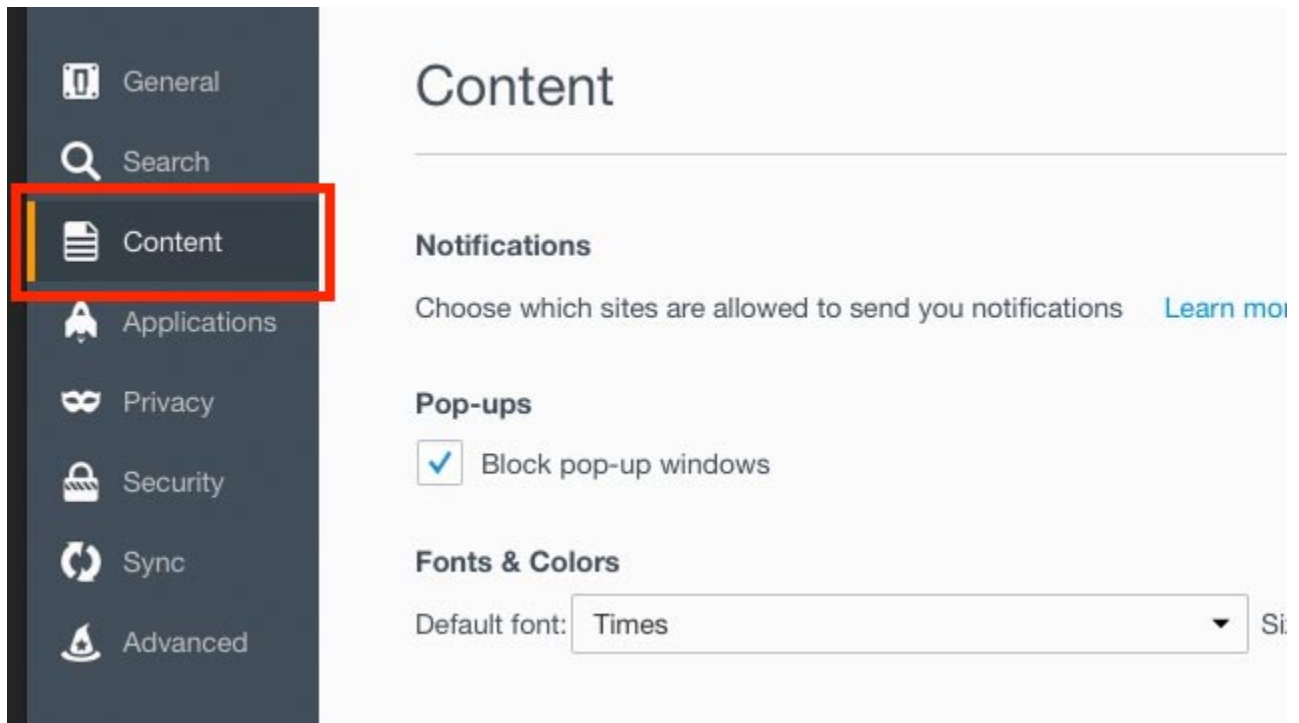

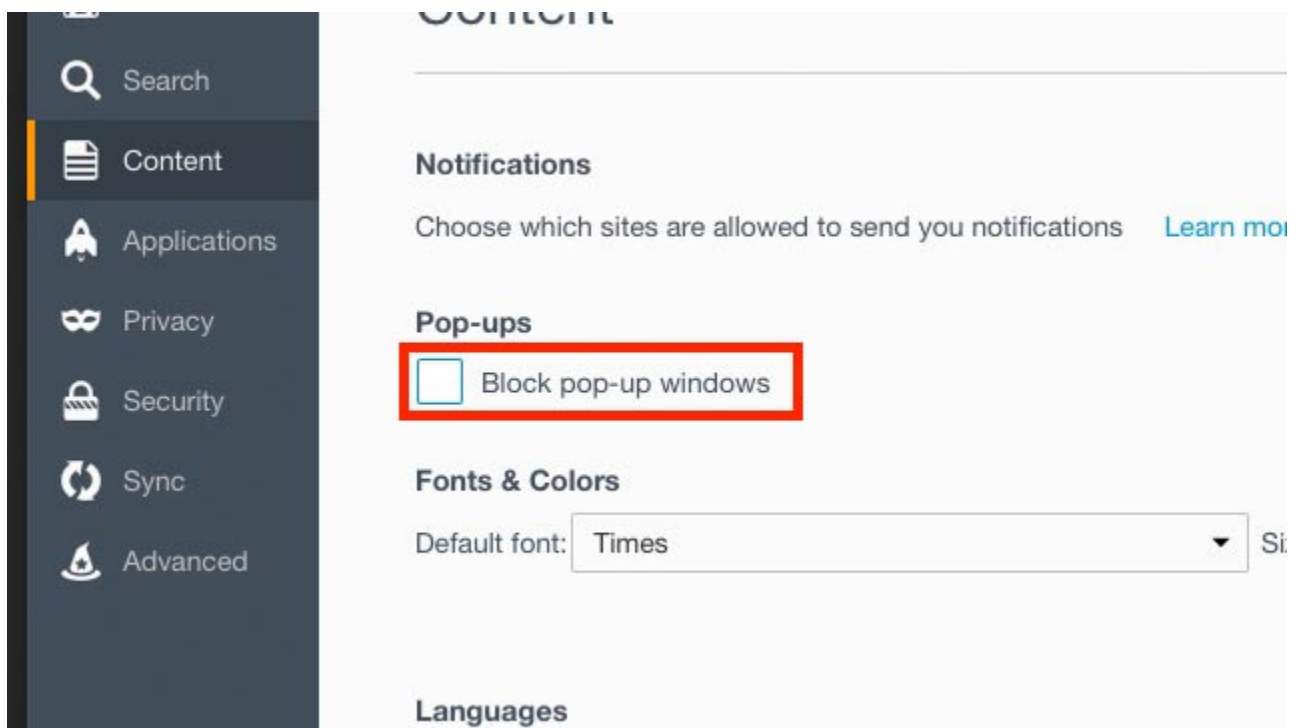
3. Click Preferences in the drop-down menu.

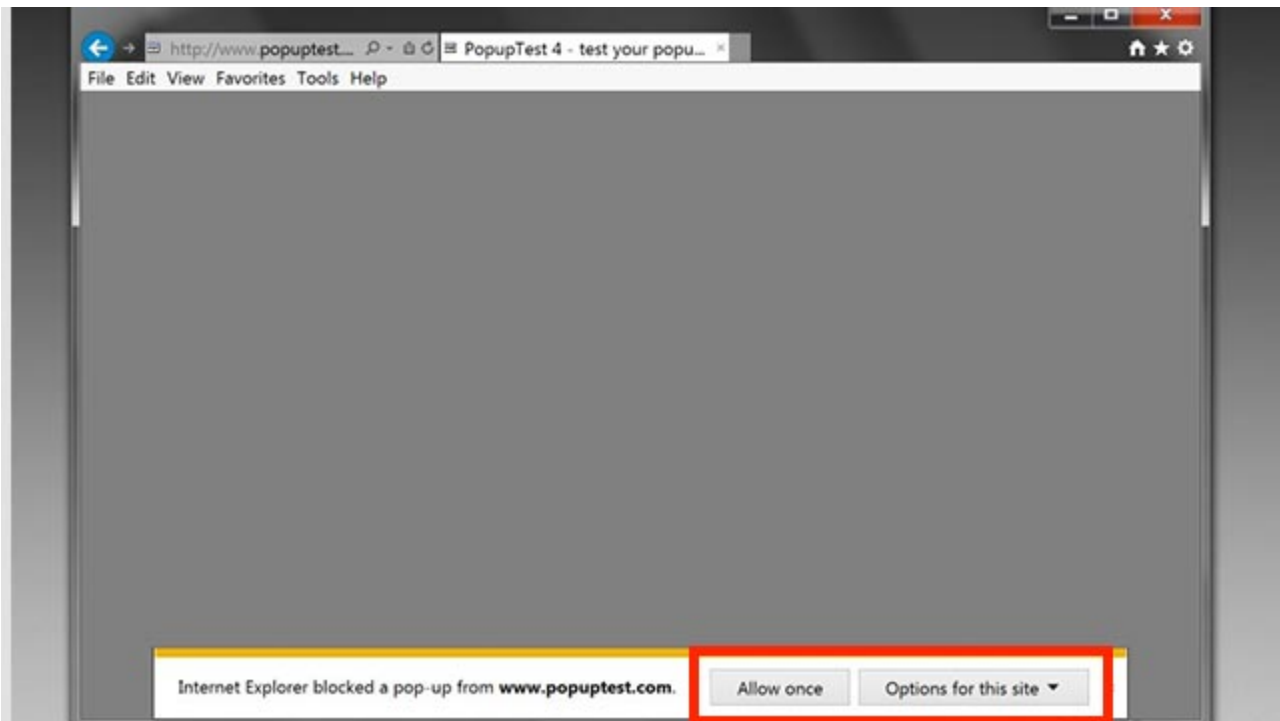
Internet Explorer

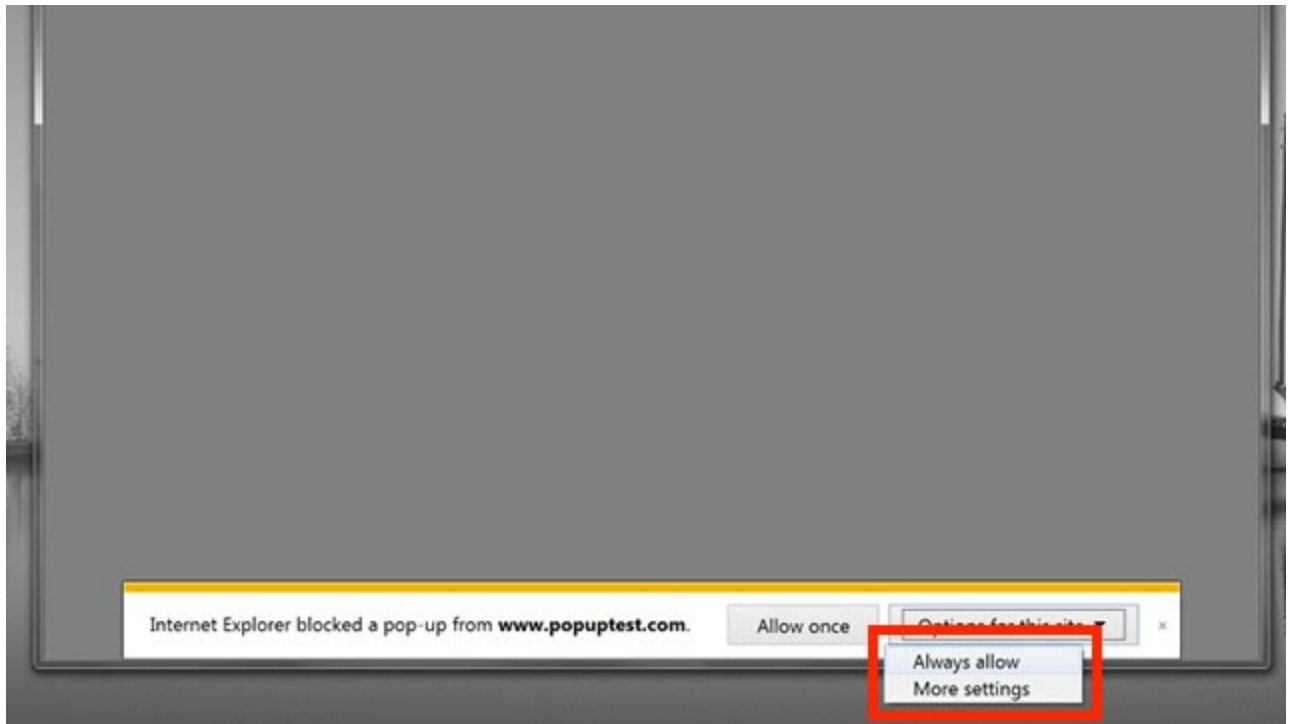

Clicking the information bar will allow you to:

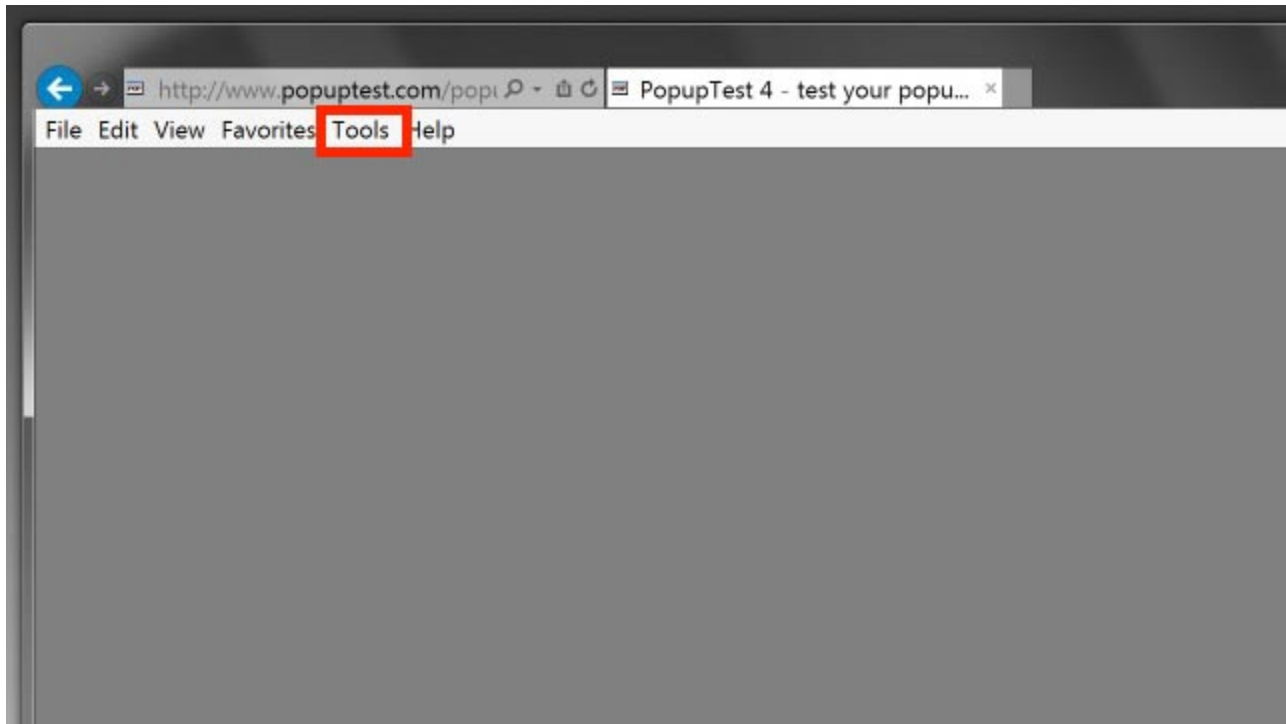
- Temporarily allow pop-ups from this site (until you close your browser)

- Adjust your pop-up blocker settings



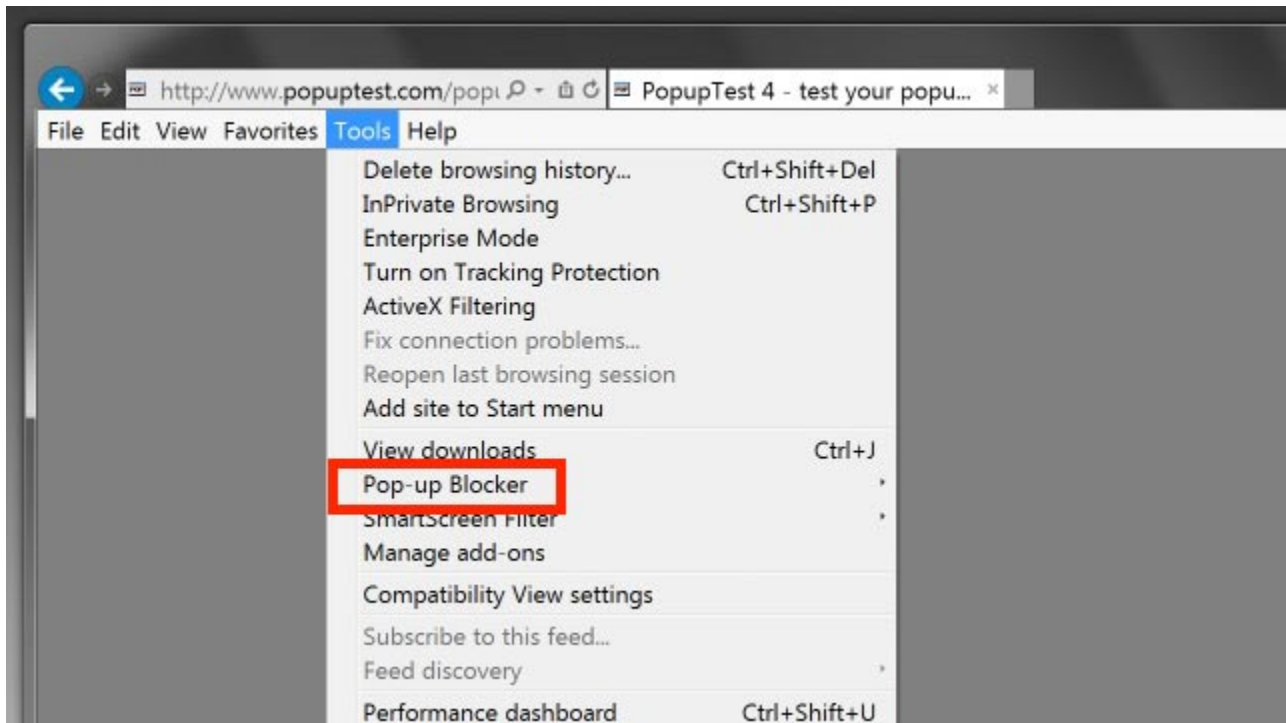


Disable a pop-up blocker within Internet Explorer settings.

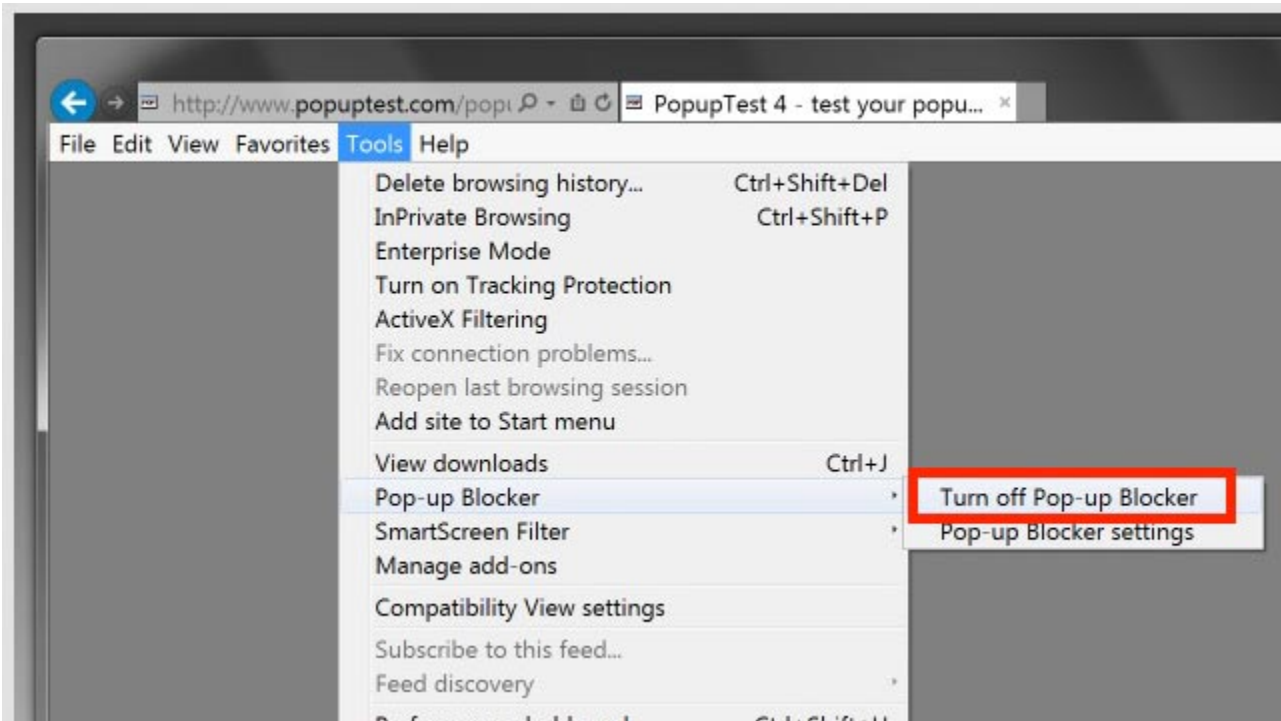
1. Open Internet Explorer.
2. Click Tools on the main menu.



3. Click Pop-up Blocker within the drop-down menu.



4. Click Turn Off Pop-Up Blocker.

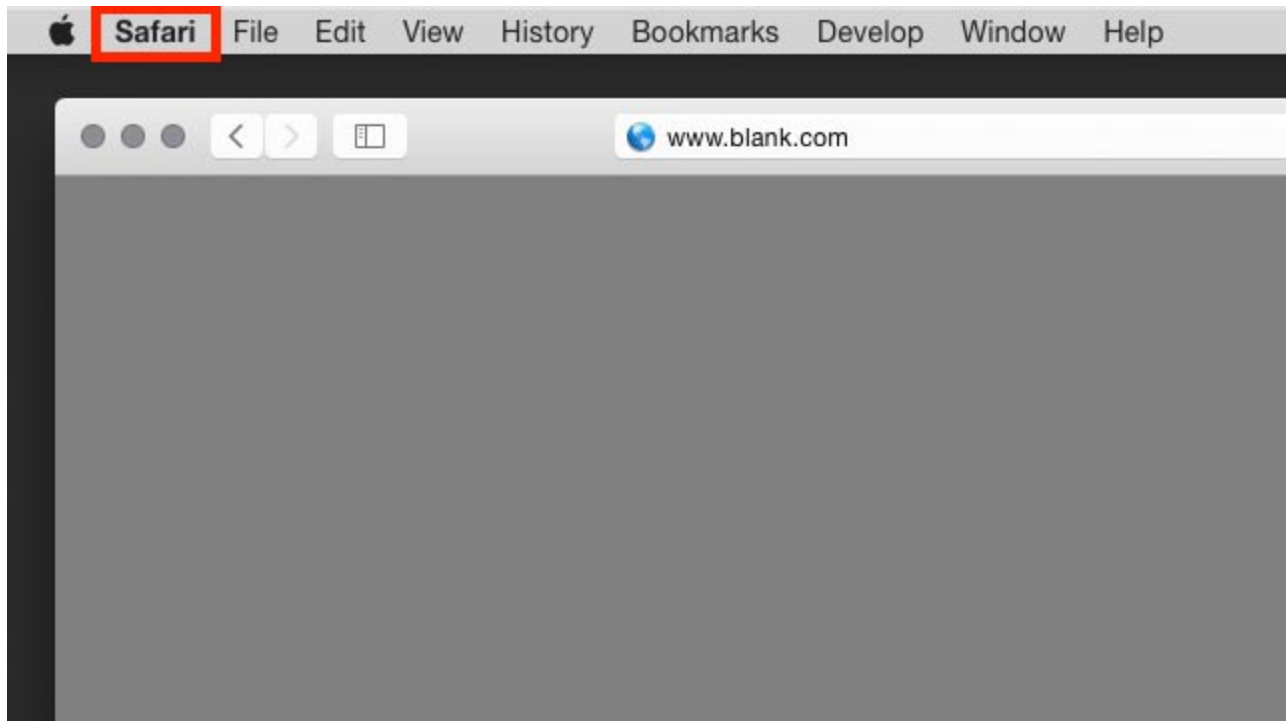


Safari for Mac

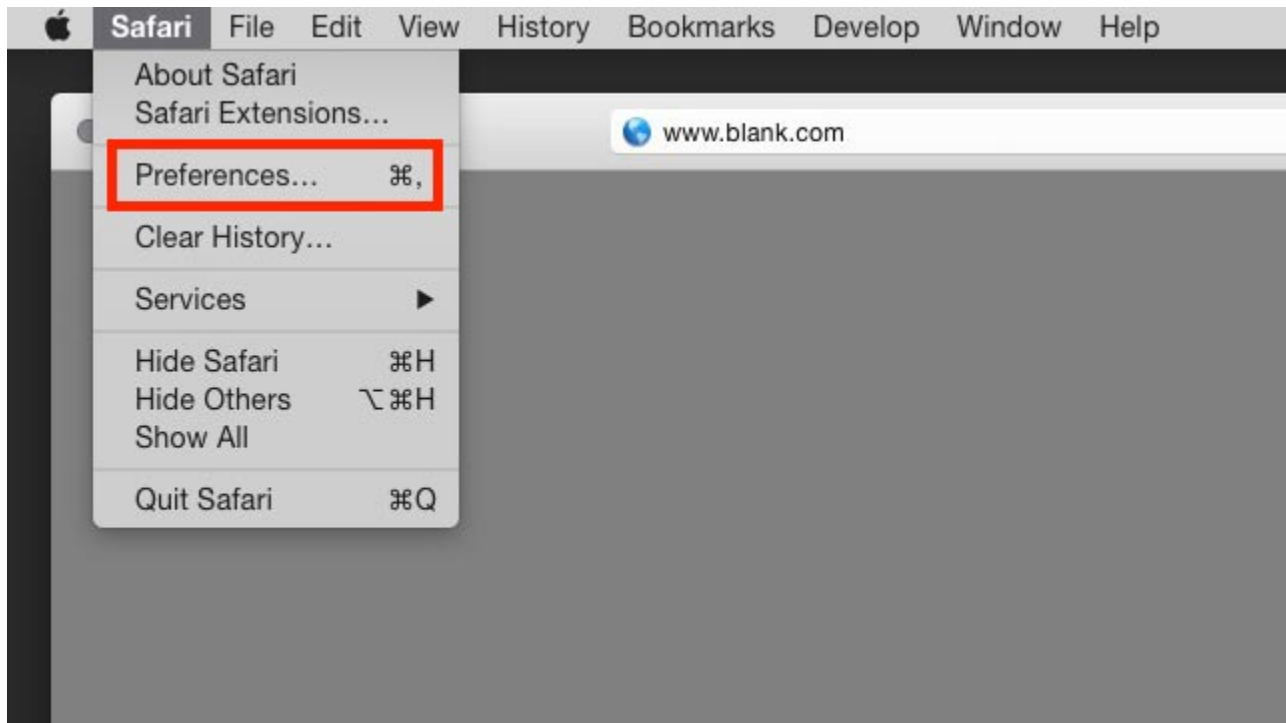
Disable a pop-up blocker within Safari settings.

When your blocker is turned on, there is no obvious alert that a pop-up has been blocked. So you'll want to go into Safari's settings to turn off the blocker.

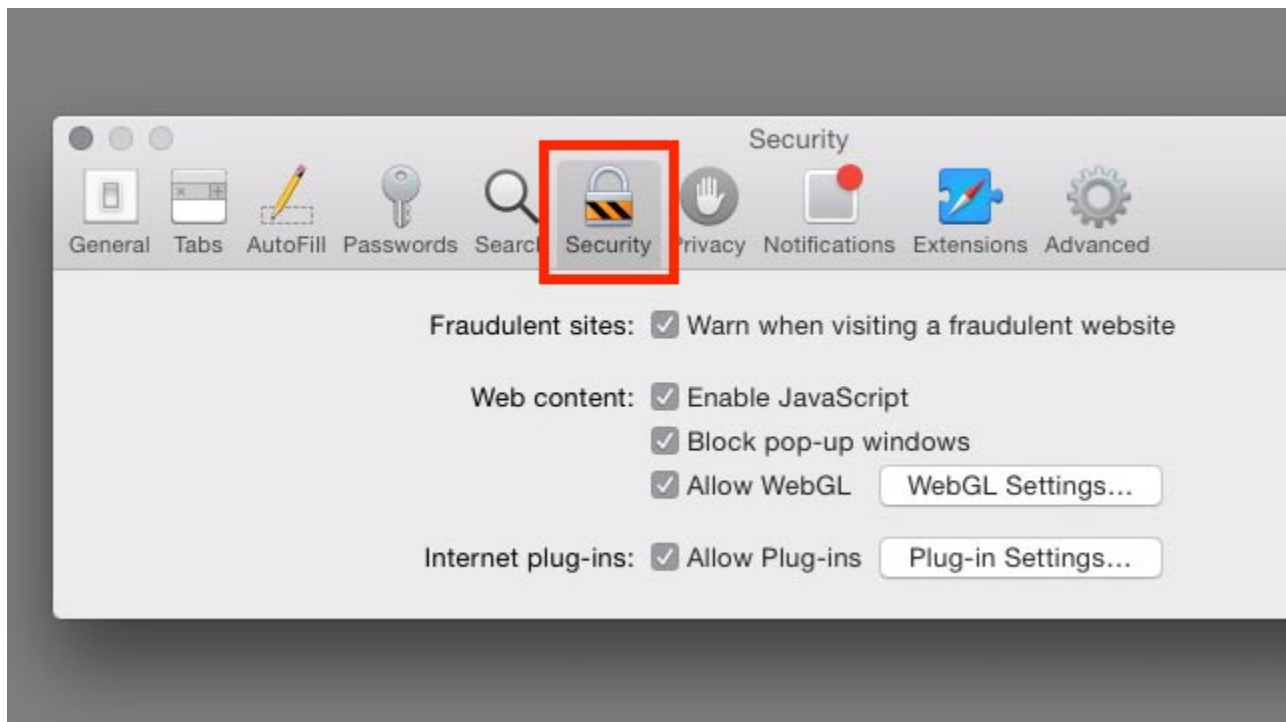
1. Open Safari.
2. In the top left of the window, click Safari.



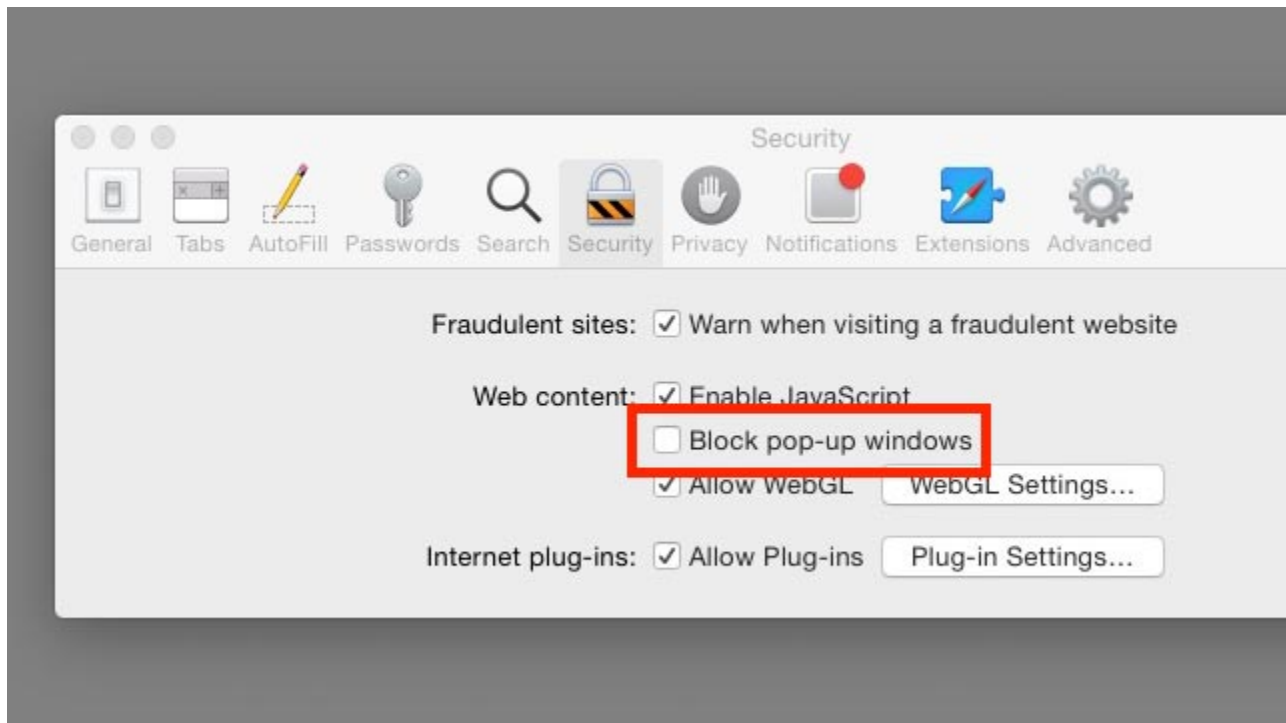
3. Click Preferences in the drop-down menu.



4. Click the Security tab found on the top row.



5. Under Web content, uncheck Block pop-up windows.



Safari for PC

Disable a pop-up blocker within Safari settings.

When your blocker is turned on, there is no obvious alert that a pop-up has been blocked. So you'll want to go into Safari's settings to turn off the blocker.

1. Open Safari.
2. In the top right of the window, click on the settings icon.



3. In the drop-down menu, uncheck Block Pop-Up Windows.
